Gottschall swore in 70 people from various countries or nationalities including Australia, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Cameroon, People's Republic of China, Ecuador, Germany, Guatemala, Haiti, Hong Kong, Iraq, Ireland, Jamaica, Malaysia, Mexico, Nigeria, Pakistan, Peru, Philippines, Poland, Romania, South Korea, Thailand and Vietnam.
