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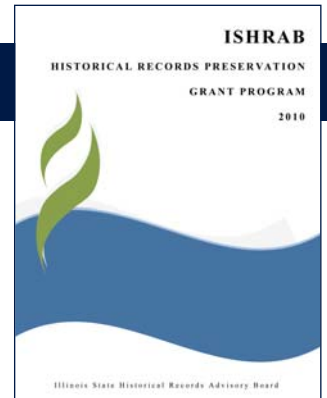
## 2010 Historical Records Preservation Grants

The Illinois State Historical Records Advisory Board (ISHRAB) is awarding grants of up to \$5,000 to Illinois historical records repositories to develop and/or carry out projects to identify, preserve, access and use historical records in Illinois. Funding for the grants is provided by the National Historical Publications and Records Commission.

At least 10 grants of up to \$5,000 each will be awarded for projects relating to preservation, access, disaster planning, collection policy formulation and equipment/supply purchases. Eligible institutions may be public or private, and although any size institution may apply, preference will be given to those with archival holdings of 500 cubic feet or less. Applicants are required to contribute a minimum one-to-one (\$1 for \$1) match of the grant funds requested, which may be met through cash or in-kind contributions.

Illinois historical records repositories, especially the smaller institutions, suffer from chronic underfunding, which sometimes results in less than adequate identification, preservation, access to and use of historical records. This grant program will allow these institutions to compete for funds to subsidize smaller archival projects that may not qualify for funding under larger grant-making agencies.

## "Understanding Archives" workshops coming

Persons new to the archives profession or who have limited archival experience will have the opportunity to attend a one-day workshop later this year provided by the Society of American Archivists (SAA). The Illinois State Historical Records Advisory Board is hosting the "Understanding Archives: An Introduction to Principles and Practices" workshops, which will provide an overview of the core archival functions of appraisal, accessioning, arrangement and description, preservation, reference and access.

Tentative plans are to hold one workshop in June and one in October. One workshop will be held in Springfield and the other at a location in either southern or western Illinois. Financial assistance will be available through an NHPRC grant.
