

EXAMPLE A **OWNER/OPERATOR (STILL IN SUSPENSION)**

- 1 Driver's License Number
(Records of mandatory insurance court supervisions, convictions and registration (plate) suspensions are maintained by driver's license number in the Mandatory Insurance System computer file.)
- 2 Court supervision and traffic violation conviction information is on the abstract of **only the operator** of an uninsured vehicle.
- 3 Date of conviction, supervision or vacating order.
- 4 Plate number of uninsured vehicle, if indicated on original ticket.
- 5 Starting date of plate suspension.
- 6 Ending date of plate suspension.
- 7 The suspension is in effect if **no date** is shown.

REASONS FOR SUSPENSION

- 8 "IVC VIOLATIONS" 3-707, 3-708, OR 3-710 if convicted by a court.
"SAMPLE" if not in compliance with the requirements of the random sampling process as reflected in 7-604 of the Code.
"ACCIDENT" if the vehicle was in an accident and certified by the Department of Transportation as uninsured.
"EVIDENCE" if the registration is suspended because the vehicle's owner submitted false evidence of insurance to the Secretary of State.
- 9 Plate number of the owner suspended.

EXAMPLE B **NON-OWNER OPERATOR**

- 10 Court supervision and traffic violation conviction information is on the abstract of **only the operator** of an uninsured vehicle.
- 11 Plate number of the owner suspended.

EXAMPLE C **OWNER (REINSTATED)**

- 12 Registration suspensions apply to all owners of an uninsured vehicle. (Suspension information is on the abstract of each **individual identified** as an owner of the vehicle.)

REASONS FOR ENDING SUSPENSION

- 13 "REINSTATED" if the vehicle owner submits evidence of insurance and pays the reinstatement fee after completing the suspension period, if required.
"RESCINDED" if proof of insurance is provided for the accident date or random sample verification date.
"VACATED" if a court vacating order is received for the conviction.

EXPLANATION OF THE MANDATORY INSURANCE ABSTRACT

Q. How do I determine if the operator of an uninsured vehicle is the owner of the vehicle?

A. If the Court Action column indicates a CONVICTION and the Registration Action column indicates a SUSPENSION for the same ticket number, this identifies an owner/operator. (See example A.)

Q. How do I determine if the operator of an uninsured vehicle is a non-owner?

A. If the Court Action column indicates a CONVICTION OR SUPERVISION and there is no corresponding registration suspension for the same ticket number, this identifies a non-owner operator. (See example B.)

Q. What is a Conviction Only?

A. If the Court Action column indicates a CONVICTION ONLY and there is no corresponding registration suspension for the same ticket number, this represents a non-owner operator conviction. A registration suspension was not processed because the registration information on the ticket did not match the Secretary of State's registration file.

Q. If the Registration Action column shows only a SUSPENSION as a result of a ticket received from the court, why doesn't the abstract show a CONVICTION?

A. The abstract is showing the owner's registration suspended as a result of a ticket conviction on a non-owner/operator driving the owner's uninsured vehicle. (See Example C.) CONVICTION information would only show on the owner's abstract if the owner was the operator. (See Example A.) To obtain the non-owner operator information, you must have the operator's driver's license number or contact the Mandatory Insurance Division.

Q. How do I request abstract information on an owner/operator or a non-owner operator showing any previous court supervisions and/or convictions?

A. Submit the driver's license numbers to obtain an abstract of operators (either owner or non-owner) who may have previous supervisions and/or convictions for operating an uninsured vehicle.

Q. How do I request abstract information on a vehicle that has its registration suspended?

A. Include the plate number of the uninsured vehicle to obtain an abstract showing the registration suspension status of the vehicle.

Q. How may I obtain actual documents regarding a mandatory insurance conviction or suspension?

A. Contact the Mandatory Insurance Division at 217-785-5923.

NOTE: Abstract information pertaining to **driver** violations other than operating an uninsured vehicle must be requested from the Secretary of State Driver Services Department.
