The Illinois Secretary of State's Ford City Driver and Vehicle Services facility will be closing its doors to the public on January 8, 2004.

Members of the public who use the Ford City facility will find access to the same services at other nearby Driver and Vehicle Services facilities including:

- Corrected titles
- Duplicate titles
- Duplicate vehicle registration cards
- Replacement vehicle stickers
- Seven day drive-away permits
- Mandatory insurance reinstatements
