**Jesse White Alerts Motorists of Vehicle Title Fee Changes Effective July 1st Due to Action by Illinois General Assembly**

*Money collected will fund statewide transportation and road improvement projects*

Illinois Secretary of State Jesse White is alerting the public of motor vehicle title fee changes, effective July 1, 2019, due to action by the Illinois General Assembly. These fee changes were a part of a capital bill that was recently signed into law and will fund statewide transportation and road improvement projects. The Secretary of State's Office collects the fees set by the legislature.

Salvage Title	\$4	\$20	7/1/2019
Junk Title	\$0	\$10	7/1/2019

Additional changes impacting vehicle registration fees will take effect January 1, 2020.
