**Macomb Driver Services Facility to Reopen on Aug. 4**

The Macomb Driver Services facility (466 Deer Rd.) will reopen on Tuesday, Aug. 4, after being temporarily closed because of the damage it sustained when a vehicle crashed into the building.

The crash occurred on June 26. The Macomb Facility's hours are Tuesday from 8 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Wednesday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday from 7:30 a.m. to noon.

As a reminder, Secretary of State Jesse White has extended all expiration dates to Nov. 1, 2020 for driver's licenses/ID cards and license plate stickers so customers do not need to rush into Driver Services facilities.

White encourages people to conduct business online at [www.cyberdriveillinois.com](http://www.cyberdriveillinois.com) such as renewing license plate stickers and obtaining replacement driver's licenses/ID cards as well as safe driver renewals.

For customers who decide to visit a facility, masks are required and people are advised to come prepared to wait outside in various weather conditions. Due to social distancing, the number of people allowed inside a facility at one time is limited.
