**Diversey Express Driver Services Facility Closed Until August 10**

Out of an abundance of caution, the Diversey Express Driver Services Facility (4642 W. Diversey Ave.) is closed until August 10 as a precaution because of an employee who tested positive for COVID-19.

The Illinois Department of Public Health has been consulted and confirmed that public is not directly impacted by this situation. Employees who work at the facility are being quarantined for 14 days and the facility is scheduled to be cleaned and sanitized according to CDC guidelines.

As a reminder, Secretary of State Jesse White has extended all expiration dates to Nov. 1, 2020 for driver's licenses/ID cards and license plate stickers so customers do not need to rush into Driver Services facilities.

White encourages people to visit [www.cyberdriveillinois.com](http://www.cyberdriveillinois.com) to conduct business online, such as renewing license plate stickers, obtaining duplicate driver's licenses/ID cards as well as safe driver renewals.

For customers who decide to visit a facility, masks are required and people are advised to come prepared to wait outside in various weather conditions. Due to social distancing, the number of people allowed inside a facility at one time is limited.

Customers can visit the nearest facilities which include Chicago North at 5401 N. Elston Ave., Chicago West at 5301 W. Lexington Ave., and Melrose Park at 1903N. Mannheim Rd. in Melrose Park.
