**South Holland CDL Facility Closed Until Sept. 1**

Out of an abundance of caution, the South Holland CDL (Commercial Driver's License) Drivers Services facility (41 W. 162nd St.) will be closed until Sept. 1 because of an employee who tested positive for COVID-19.

The Illinois Department of Public Health has been consulted and confirmed that the public is not directly impacted by this situation. Employees who work at the facility are being quarantined for 14 days and the facility is scheduled to be cleaned and sanitized according to CDC guidelines and will reopen on Sept. 1.

As a reminder, Secretary of State Jesse White has extended all expiration dates to Nov. 1, 2020 for driver's licenses/ID cards and license plate stickers so customers do not need to rush into Driver Services facilities.

White encourages people to conduct business online at [www.cyberdriveillinois.com](http://www.cyberdriveillinois.com) for services such as renewing license plate stickers and obtaining replacement driver's licenses/ID cards as well as safe driver renewals.

For customers who decide to visit a facility, masks are required. Customers are advised to come prepared to wait outside in various weather conditions. Due to social distancing, the number of people allowed inside a facility at one time is limited.

CDL drivers are encouraged to visit the nearest facilities which include West Chicago (1280 Powis Rd.), and Bradley (1111 Blatt Blvd.).
