South Holland CDL Driver Services Facility Reopens Tuesday, Sept. 1

The South Holland CDL Driver Services facility (41 W. 162nd St.) reopens Tuesday, Sept. 1 after closing as a precaution because of an employee who tested positive for COVID-19. The facility has been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected.

White reiterated to the public that expiration dates for driver's licenses/ID cards and vehicle registration stickers have been extended until Nov. 1, 2020, so customers do not need to rush into a facility. During hot weather it is suggested customers consider delaying their visit, but if customers must visit a facility, they are encouraged to come prepared to wait outside due to social distancing, which limits the number of people inside a facility at one time.

Customers are also encouraged to conduct transactions online at www.cyberdriveillinois.com if possible. Those who do business online will not have to wait in line at a facility.

Customers and Secretary of State employees are required to wear face masks, and social distancing measures are in place.
