Chicago South Driver Services Facility Closed Until Nov. 19

Out of an abundance of caution, the Chicago South Driver Services facility (9901 S. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr.) is closed until Thursday, Nov. 19 because of an employee who tested positive for COVID-19.

The Illinois Department of Public Health has been consulted. Employees who work at the facility are being quarantined for 14 days and the facility is scheduled to be disinfected and sanitized according to CDC guidelines.

As a reminder, Secretary of State Jesse White has extended expiration dates to Feb. 1, 2021, for driver's licenses/ID cards so customers do not need to rush into Driver Services facilities.

White encourages people to conduct business online at www.cyberdriveillinois.com for services such as renewing license plate stickers, obtaining replacement driver's licenses/ID cards and renewing as a safe driver.

For customers who decide to visit a facility, masks are required and people are advised to come prepared to wait outside in various weather conditions. Due to social distancing, the number of people allowed inside a facility at one time is limited.

Drivers can visit the nearest facilities, which include: Bridgeview, 7358 W. 87th St.; Midlothian, 14434 S. Pulaski Ave.; and Chicago West, 5301 W. Lexington Ave.
