Belleville Driver Services Facility Closed Until Nov. 10

Out of an abundance of caution, the Belleville Driver Services facility (400 W. Main) is closed until Tuesday, Nov. 10 because of an employee who tested positive for COVID-19.

The Illinois Department of Public Health has been consulted. Employees who work at the facility are being quarantined for 14 days and the facility is scheduled to be disinfected and sanitized according to CDC guidelines.

As a reminder, Secretary of State Jesse White has extended expiration dates to Feb. 1, 2021, for driver's licenses/ID cards so customers do not need to rush into Driver Services facilities. License plate stickers remain extended until Nov. 1, 2020.

White encourages people to conduct business online at www.cyberdriveillinois.com for services such as renewing license plate stickers, obtaining replacement driver's licenses/ID cards and safe driver renewals.

For customers who decide to visit a facility, masks are required and people are advised to come prepared to wait outside in various weather conditions. Due to social distancing, the number of people allowed inside a facility at one time is limited.

Drivers can visit the nearest facilities, which include Mascoutah (9221 Beller Dr.), Granite City (1810 Edison) and Edwardsville (1502A Troy Rd.).
