**Carbondale Driver Services Facility Closed Until Oct. 13**

Due to the order of the Franklin-Williamson Bi-county Health Department, employees at the Carbondale Driver Services facility have been directed to quarantine due to an employee testing positive for COVID-19. As a result, the Carbondale Driver Services facility (2516 W. Murphysboro Rd.) is closed until Oct. 13.

The public is not directly impacted by the employee that tested positive. The facility is scheduled to be cleaned and sanitized according to CDC guidelines before reopening on Oct. 13.

As a reminder, Secretary of State Jesse White has extended all expiration dates to Feb. 1, 2020, for driver's licenses and ID cards, so customers do not need to rush into Driver Services facilities.

White encourages people to conduct business online at [www.cyberdriveillinois.com](http://www.cyberdriveillinois.com), such as renewing license plate stickers and obtaining replacement driver's licenses/ID cards as well as safe driver renewals.

For customers who decide to visit a facility, masks are required. Customers are advised to come prepared to wait outside in various weather conditions. Due to social distancing, the number of people allowed inside a facility at one time is limited.

Drivers can visit the nearest facilities, which include: Marion at 1905 Rendleman St., Anna at 101A Transcraft Dr. and Benton at 812 N. Main St.
