White Announces New West Chicago CDL Driver Services Facility to Open Tuesday, May 25

Secretary of State Jesse White announced that the new West Chicago Commercial Driver License (CDL) Driver Services facility will be open on Tuesday, May 25. This facility, which will serve CDL customers only, is located at 721 Kress Road in West Chicago. This new CDL facility replaces the old facility located at 1280 Powis Road in West Chicago.

“Commercial truck drivers provide essential services by ensuring goods can be transported safely and efficiently throughout the state and country,” said White. “I am pleased that this facility will provide CDL customers with these essential services.”

Hours for the West Chicago CDL Driver Services facility will be Tuesday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday 7:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. Customers can apply for a first time CDL, renew a CDL or purchase a license plate sticker in addition to many other services. In addition, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has extended the federal REAL ID deadline to May 3, 2023.

This includes renewing license plate stickers, obtaining duplicate driver’s licenses or ID cards, and renewing driver’s licenses and ID cards online for those that are eligible.
