



## **DONALD J. TRUMP**

### **President of the United States**

Donald J. Trump (Republican) was sworn in as the 45th President of the United States on Jan. 20, 2017. Throughout his life, Trump has continually set the standards of business and entrepreneurial excellence, especially in real estate, sports and entertainment. Likewise, his entry into politics and public service resulted in the presidential victory of his first run for office.

After graduating from the Wharton School of Finance, Trump followed in his father's footsteps and entered the world of real estate development in New York City. The Trump signature soon became synonymous with the most prestigious of addresses in Manhattan and, subsequently, throughout the world. President Trump has authored 14 bestsellers, including his first book, "The Art of the Deal."

President Trump announced his candidacy on June 16, 2015, and after 17 Republican contenders suspended their campaigns, he accepted the Republican nomination for President of the United States in July 2016. Trump won the election on Nov. 8, 2016. He won more than 2,600 counties nationwide and won over 62 million votes in the popular vote. He won 306 electoral votes, the most for a Republican since George H.W. Bush in 1988.

President Trump was born in Queens, New York, on June 14, 1946. He and his wife, Melania, have one son, Barron. Additionally, President Trump has four adult children — Donald Jr., Ivanka, Eric and Tiffany — and nine grandchildren.
