

# If your driver's license or ID card is lost or stolen

File a police report immediately.

Go to a Secretary of State facility to get a duplicate. You will need documentation to prove your identity.

Contact your credit card company(s).

Contact your bank(s) to protect your banking accounts.

Contact the Social Security Fraud Line at 1-800-269-0271

Call the three national credit reporting organizations listed below to place a fraud alert on your name and social security number. This alert means any company that checks your credit knows your information was stolen, and they have to contact you by phone to authorize new credit.
