ILLINOIS STATE LIBRARY

I-Share Library Database: Access to more than 30 million items in 65 academic libraries in the state, including the collection of the Illinois State Library. A State Library card is available to all state employees and elected officials. Materials may be picked up at the State Library or sent to your office.

Researchers: Experienced librarians to assist you with your information needs.

Collections: More than 7 million items at the State Library, including federal and state government publications, technical standards, journals and newspapers.

Maps: More than 185,000 maps, including topographic maps for all 50 states, plat books and county atlases for Illinois, Sanborn Fire Insurance maps, census maps and aerial photographs of Illinois and more.

Patents, Trademarks & Copyright: Extensive collection and resources dating back to 1790, and expert assistance in conducting searches.

INFORM: Table of contents service from selected journals available through subscription for state employees and elected officials.

Internet Access: Computers available on the second floor of the library.

Interlibrary Loan: Access to more than 20,000 library collections worldwide.
