



# RECLASSIFICATION TO RV

## 625 ILCS 5/1-145.01 — Motor Home, Mini Motor Home or Van Camper definition:

A self-contained motor vehicle, not used commercially, designed or permanently converted to provide living quarters for recreational, camping or travel use, with direct walk-through access to the living quarters from the driver's seat. Such vehicles must include at least four of the following:

- a) A cooking facility with an on-board fuel source;
- b) A gas or electric refrigerator;
- c) A toilet with exterior evacuation;
- d) A heating or air conditioning system with an on-board power or fuel source separate from the vehicle engine;
- e) A potable water supply system that includes at least a sink, a faucet, and a water tank with an exterior service supply connection;
- f) A 110-125 volt electric power supply.

### Checklist:

To qualify for the statutorily defined classification of motor home, mini motor home or van camper, a vehicle **must**:

- Be self-contained (possessing within itself all that is necessary; self-sufficient);
- Not to be used commercially (transporting persons or property in furtherance of a commercial or industrial enterprise, for-hire or not-for-hire);
- Be designed (initial manufacture), or **permanently** converted, to provide living quarters;
- Provide direct **walk-through** access between the living quarters and driver's seat;
- **Only** be used for recreation, camping or travel; and
- Include at least four of the following **permanently mounted** items:
  - Cooking facility (stove, oven, etc.) with an on-board fuel source;
  - Refrigerator (gas or electric);
  - Toilet with exterior evacuation (storage tank and dumping capability);
  - Heating or air conditioning system with on-board power/fuel separate from the vehicle's engine;
  - Potable (drinkable) water supply system including a sink, faucet, and water tank (with exterior service supply connection); or 110-125-volt electric power supply.

In addition. If the vehicle has been materially altered from its original construction by the removal, addition or substitution of essential parts, it must undergo inspection and titling as a "specially constructed vehicle."
